

## Guidance for Authors

### PRACTICE, RESEARCH AND INNOVATION SECTION

Manuscripts, prepared according to the following Guidance for Authors are invited on all aspects of hospital pharmacy, including scientific, clinical, therapeutic, economic and social disciplines. Please refer to the 'Guidance for Authors' of *EJHP Science* for further details. High quality research papers, reviews and practice guidelines in the field of hospital pharmacy practice will be considered for the Practice, Research and Innovation Section in the EJHP-P and are subject to peer review. Original research, case reports and review articles will be considered for publication in the *European Journal of Hospital Pharmacy Science (EJHP-S)*.

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Number references consecutively in the order in which they are first mentioned in the text. Identify references in text, tables and legends by Arabic numerals in square brackets. Only papers closely related to the authors' work should be cited. Exhaustive lists should be avoided. Please follow the style given in the Uniform Requirements for Manuscripts Submitted to Biomedical Journals\*, except if the number of authors is six or fewer, list all names or if the number of authors is seven or more, list only the first three followed by et al. Author's names (initials preceded by surname, no periods after initials), complete title of the article, name of journal (Index Medicus abbreviation), year/month, volume, issue, page numbers. Include the city and publisher's name for books.
